Rebecca L. Davies, a member of the Senior Executive Service, is the Director, Air Force Program Management and Acquisition Excellence, Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Air Force for Acquisition, Washington, D.C. The center is a selectively manned organization chartered to transform Air Force acquisition into a capability-based system with speed and credibility. The center advocates for innovation and change to redefine how the Air Force procures affordable, effective weapon systems for the warfighter.

Ms. Davies began her federal career in 1989 as a Foreign Military Sales program analyst assigned to the Defense Security Assistance Division within the Naval Air Systems Command. She held various positions within this command, including program manager for the \$2 billion procurement of 34 F/A-18 fighter aircraft and related support for the government of Switzerland. She was also the program manager for the planning, acquisition, delivery and life-cycle support of the F/A-18 Training System for the Navy, Marine Corps and Reserve squadrons with a five-year operating budget in excess of \$550 million. Ms. Davies then spent five years with the Joint Strike Fighter Program, a joint service fighter aircraft acquisition program with Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force and major foreign participation.



Prior to her current assignment, she was the Executive Director for Operations Management and Customer Relations at the Defense Contract Management Agency, Alexandria, Va. She was responsible for developing, managing, and ensuring the effective implementation and adequacy of contract management policies, procedures, and processes to support the missions of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Defense agencies, NASA and other federal agencies.
