

## **Captain L. Scott Hollingsworth**

Capt L. Scott Hollingsworth enlisted in the Air Force in 1989, where he served as a medical administrative specialist and non-prior service recruiter. He received a commission as a Second Lieutenant in 2004 from the 850th Air Force ROTC in Salt Lake City, Utah, graduating summa cum laude and as a Distinguished Graduate. Serving as a Finance Officer, Lieutenant Hollingsworth received an appointment to the US Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, CA, where he received a Master's in Business Administration in Finance. His thesis project "Solving the Principal-Agent Problem in Iraq: Economic Incentives Create a New Model for Security," won the Outstanding Thesis Award. It was later published by the Daniel Patrick Moynihan Institute of Global Affairs, the Maxwell School of Syracuse University. Captain Hollingsworth served as the Budget Chief at Travis AFB, CA from 2008 - 2010. He is now the Comptroller at the 33d Fighter Wing here at Eglin.
