Ms. Carr is the Director of Certification at the American Society of Military Comptrollers. In this capacity she heads the on-going training, education and credentialing efforts for the organization. The Enhanced Defense Financial Management Training (EDFMT), Federal Appropriations Law, and Acquisition Business Management courses are under her supervision and administration. She oversees the Certified Defense Financial Manager Program (CDFM), the College Credit Referral program through the American Council on Education, and all other related matters for the ASMC. Ms. Carr serves as a member of the Certification Commission, and is the psychometric expert (performing examination statistical analyses) for the organization.

Prior to joining the ASMC, Ms. Carr worked as a financial management consultant for a Defense contractor where she led multi-billion dollar foreign military sales efforts. In this capacity, she served as liaison for several countries and oversaw all aspects of contract execution from equipment manufacture to final delivery.
