Mr. Michael J. Halloran is the Director, FM Center of Expertise, Denver, CO. As the Organization's Director he is responsible for overseeing the daily operations of the CoE as it provides financial analytical support to Air Force installations and Major Commands. He leads a team of 40 military, civilian, and contractor professional analysts responsible for providing decision support to MAJCOM and base level financial managers.
