

Colonel David Peeler is Deputy Director of Financial Management and Comptroller for the Air Force Life Cycle Management Center. He is responsible for training and equipping over 2,000 financial personnel, as well as oversight and advice regarding funds under management worth \$238B across the Center. He assists in policy formulation, interpretation, and implementation, providing executive supervision with regard to budget execution and centralized cost estimating management; influencing over 4,600 programs/projects valued in excess of \$1T.

Colonel Peeler graduated Blacksburg High School in 1984. After graduating from Berea College in 1988 and work as a manager in several private-sector concerns, he was commissioned via Officer Training School in late 1992. He has worked in all four comptroller functional areas at acquisition and operation locations, as well as two brief stints as a program manager.
